TREATMENT CUM REHABILITATION CENTRE FOR ADDICTS(IRCA):

Continuous effort of "PEACE BIRD OF CAPABILITY" in the process of campaign against alcoholism and substance drug abuse has been well recognized by the Ministry of School Justice and Empowerment, Govt. of India in the year 1999. And the Ministry has been providing financial inputs to run a 15 bedded Integrated Rehabilitation centre for Addicts (IRCA) in the banner of "SAKSHYAM". The centre has been involved in identifying the Addicts and analyzing the depth of the problem, counseling to addicts and families. Both indoor and outdoor 170 No's addicts have been registered during the year 2020-21 total 170 no of patient out of which 170 Addicts have been detoxified and out

ENVIRONMENT DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME

Like every year, in the year under report, the organization had organized the environment awareness programme with the theme "Forests for Sustainable Livelihood". Jyotsna Das Managing Director, Peace Bird of Capability was presided the program and Sarpanch of Orangi G.p was the chief guest to address on the occasion, MPS of Orangi G.P guest of honor, P.D.Drugs Programme guest of honor and women SHGs members participant of the program held at Orangi Gram Panchayat premises of Balesore Block on 5th March 2020. In this occasion we would organized a rally with ply-card for save their livelihood from forests.

Plantation Programme:-

The organization has implemented one plantation project in the Orangi under Balesore district. We have planted 7,000 saplings of Eucalyptus, Akasia & Casuarina etc. There is lots of Wasteland in this area, which also can be done plantation in more land. The organization has also conducted several training programmes to aware the local people with the guidance of forest departments on the above programmes.

Community Education on prevention of HIV/AIDS

In the changing scenario of changing lifestyle, occupational pressure and sexual behavior HIV / AIDS has grown into a major concern for the present society. As such there is a need to aware the general public and to promote safe-sex practices.

The township of Balesore and the industrial township of Remuna area are more prone to spread of this health - hazard owing to the massive human activities and migration in these regions.
